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## Bilibo at the Museum of Modern Art New York



## Growing by Design

**On July 29 the MoMA New York opened its new exhibition “Century of the Child: Growing by Design, 1900-2000”. The ambitious survey of 20th century design for children is the first large-scale overview of the modernist preoccupation with children and childhood as a paradigm for progressive design thinking. Bilibo, the widely acclaimed toy by Swiss designer Alex Hochstrasser, is part of the exhibition.**

The inclusion in the MoMA show marks a new highlight in the success story of this rather unique toy. Contrary to all trends towards more electronic gadgets, Hochstrasser has developed a simple, abstract play object that relies entirely on a child’s imagination and instincts to play. In contrast to most common toys Bilibo has neither a clearly defined function nor a single use - like a cardboard box it can be turned into anything children want it to be and only in their hands does it come alive.

Like the famous toys by Kurt Naef from the 50ies (which are also part of the MoMA exhibition) Bilibo has become a new icon for modern Swiss design and is beloved by children, parents and educators alike. It was awarded the German Spiel Gut seal as well as voted toy of the year in the UK, USA, Japan and Australia. The Independent even included Bilibo in its survey of “50 great ideas for the 21st century”.

Since 2012 Bilibo is being produced and distributed exclusively by the new Swiss label MOLUK. The small company based in Zurich was founded by Alex Hochstrasser and his architect sister Doris as a creative laboratory. MOLUK develops innovative toys and objects that engage and empower children to become active and creative - true to MoMA’s motto “Growing by Design”.
